THE ISSUES CHOSEN

Candidates were asked their positions on a series of issues that New Yorkers are deeply concerned about today:

1. Inflation/The Economy, 2. Illegal Immigration, 3. Crime

Candidates were then asked a series of yes or no questions on select isssues that affect New York City the most:

- 1. Congestion Pricing: A proposed toll that drivers would pay to enter Lower Manhattan. Currently on an indefinite pause.
- 2. Reinstate & Compensate: Proposed legislation that would restore workers, who were fired for refusing the covid vaccine, with possibility of backpay for time lost.
- 3. E-Bike Regulation: Proposed sets of bills that would require licensure and registration of e-bikes and mopeds that have caused havoc on our streets.
- 4. Good Cause Eviction: A current law that strengthens tenant protections while weakening private property rights.
 5. The "City of Yes": A proposed residential re-zoning within NYC which will attempt to increase housing & economic
